## ORIGAMI FOR FATHER'S DAY



FACE


Materials and supplies:

- 1 rectangle piece of paper with a 1:2 ratio, $3^{\prime \prime}$ $x 6$ ", skin toned, can be colored on one side only, as the back does not show
- glue stick or white glue for assembly
- black and pink colored pencils or markers

1. With the white (or back) side facing up, line up one short edge to the opposite short edge and crease.
2. Keep folded.
3. Rotate $45^{\circ}$.
4. Line up one corner with the opposite corner and crease.
5. Unfold.
6. Rotate $90^{\circ}$.
7. Line up the other corner with the opposite corner and crease.
8. Unfold.
9. Line up one corner with the center point and crease.
10. Repeat Step 9 for two of other three corners.

11. For the fourth corner, fold the point up part way, not all the way up to the center point. The distance folded up should be the same as the gap between the point and the center point.
12. Then, for this fourth corner, fold the point down making a narrow, horizontal pleat.
13. Situate the model so the fourth corner is at the bottom.
14. For the other three corners, unfold the corners on the left and right.
15. Working on the corner on the right, fold the lower edge to line up with the vertical crease next to it.
16. Keep folded.
17. Then fold the upper edge to line up with the same vertical crease.
18. Keep folded.
19. Repeat Steps 15 through 18 for the corner on the left.
20. Flip over.

## HAIR

Materials and supplies:

- 1 rectangle piece of paper with a $1: 2$ ratio, 3 " x 6 ", hair colored, can be colored on one side only, as the back does not show

1. With the white (or back) side facing up, line up one short edge to the opposite short edge and crease.
2. Unfold.
3. Line up one long edge to the opposite long edge and crease.
4. Unfold.

5. Line up the horizontal edge at the top right with the vertical center crease and crease.
6. Unfold.
7. Repeat Steps 5 and 6 for the horizontal edge at the top left.
8. Line up the vertical edge on the right with the diagonal crease next to it and crease.
9. Keep folded.
10. Repeat Steps 8 and 9 for the vertical edge on the left.
11. For the top right corner only, make a shaping, triangular fold in and down approximately 1/8".
12. Refold the diagonal creases you made in Steps 5 and 6.
13. Keep folded.
14. Flip over.
15. Fold the top point down to the center point and crease.
16. Flip over.
17. To assemble, insert the face inside the hair, lining up both pieces along their vertical center creases.
18. Holding both pieces in place, you can also check the alignment on the back side to make sure.
19. Starting on the right side, fold back the right side of the hair to line up with the right side of the face.
20. Repeat on the left side.
